Five Ways to Help Safeguard Your Family Member's Identities and Online Privacy:

1. Be smart when sharing your personal information and shopping online. Keep your passwords strong and secure, avoid using public Wi-Fi, and destroy unneeded documents that contain your personal information.
2. If you are the victim of a data breach, change your usernames and passwords immediately.
3. Protect your child's identity. Children are not immune to identity theft. It is important, if you have a child, to keep his/her SSN and other information secure.
4. Be cautious of unexpected texts and emails. Phishing scams, especially ones that mimic charities, are popular during crises or holidays. Be sure to donate only to well-known charities.
5. Proactively monitor your personal information with an identity theft plan.
